

## APPLY FOR ADVANCE BALLOT NOW

Requests for Advance Voting Ballots by mail for the 2016 General Election in Elk County are currently being accepted and ballots will be mailed out beginning October 19<sup>th</sup>. Please get your application in early.

Walk-In Advance Voting will begin in the Elk County Clerk's Office on Monday, October 24<sup>th</sup>, and will continue until noon November 7<sup>th</sup>. Photo I.D. will be required to vote. Acceptable forms of photo I.D. are:

- A driver's license or non-driver's identification card issued by Kansas or by another state or district of the United States
- A concealed carry of handgun license issued by a state or district in the United States
- An United States passport
- An employee badge or identification document issued by a municipal, county, state, or federal government office
- A military identification document issued by the United States
- A student identification card issued by an accredited postsecondary institution of education in the State of Kansas
- A public assistance identification card issued by a municipal, county, state or federal government office
- An identification card issued by an Indian tribe
