

**COVID 19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY
RESOLUTION 20-04 EXTENDED UNTIL RESCINDED**

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of March, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Elk County, Kansas declared there was a state of local public health emergency in Elk County, Kansas resulting in potential or occurring Pandemic known as COVID 19, in Elk County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, on the 17th day of May, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Elk County, Kansas declared the extension of the state of local public health emergency in Elk County, Kansas resulting in potential or occurring Pandemic known as COVID 19, in Elk County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, such conditions endanger the public health, safety and welfare of persons within the borders of Elk County, Kansas.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Elk County, Kansas:


That the state of local public health emergency in Elk County, Kansas declared on the 19th day of March 2020 and extended sixty days on the 16th day of May, shall continue and remain in effect until rescinded.

That the response and recovery aspects of all local disaster plans which are applicable to Elk County, Kansas and shall initiate the rendering of aid and assistance there under.

That any rights or powers lawfully exercised or any actions taken pursuant to local disaster emergency plans shall continue and have full force and effect as authorized by law until rescinded in the manner prescribed by law.


