

Resolution 20-03

Elk County Commissioners passed Resolution 20-03 relative to the Coronavirus (COVID-19). In addition to closing the public schools in Elk County from March 16 – 20, 2020, the Commission recommends to all citizens to implement the policy of social distancing, to avoid unnecessary travel, handshaking, and attempt to do as much business and interaction as is necessary virtually or by teleconference in an effort to slow the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19).

The Commissioners also want the public to be aware that groceries and prescriptions can be delivered from Family Market and Batson's Drug Store according to their current policies, which include daily deliveries to Howard and Moline, and weekly deliveries to Elk Falls and Longton.

Elk County General Public Transportation continues to transport, unless you have a fever, are coughing and experiencing shortness of breath or believe you have the flu. In those situations, you should contact your physician.

The elderly population and those with underlying health issues should consider staying at home as much as possible, have your meals delivered and avoid contact with those who are ill. You can contact the Elk County Health Department with questions or for future updates.
