Resolution No. 22-04 and Proclamation

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A STATE OF LOCAL DISASTER EMERGENCY FOR

ELK COUNTY, KS

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of March, 2022 the Board of County Commissioners for Elk County, Kansas, finds that certain conditions caused, or eminently threaten to cause wide-spread or severe damage, injury or loss of life or property in disaster proportions in Elk County, Kansas; and

WHEREAS, such conditions have created obstructions which endanger health, safety and welfare of persons and property within the border of Elk County, Kansas.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Elk County, Kansas:

That the Board of County Commissioners of Elk County, Kansas, under and by virtue of the authority vested in it by K.S.A. 1976 Supp. 48-932, does hereby proclaim that a State of Local Disaster Emergency exists.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that said Board has all rights and /or powers to perform such functions as are vested in said Board by and through the provisions of the Kansas Emergency Preparedness Act of 1975.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall remain in effect for seven (7) days unless terminated earlier or renewed by consent of the governing body.
