## Call County & Rural Fire RNR and Budget Hearings to Order

Chairman Liebau called the revenue neutral rate and budget hearings to order at 1:00 p.m. in the Commissioner's room of the Elk County Courthouse. Commissioners Hendricks and Russell were all present as well as County Clerk Kerry Harrod and County Counselor Paul Dean.

## County Revenue Neutral Rate & Budget Hearings

Commissioner Hendricks moved and Commissioner Russell seconded the motion to approve resolution 24-10 a resolution of the County of Elk to levy a property tax rate exceeding the revenue neutral rate. Motion carried 3-0. Commissioner Hendricks moved and Commissioner Russell seconded the motion to approve resolution 24-11 a roll call vote of Elk County to levy a property tax exceeding the revenue neutral rate. Motion carried 3-0. Commissioner Hendricks moved and Commissioner Russell seconded the motion to approve and adopt the 2025 County Budget as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

### Rural Fire District #1 Revenue Neutral Rate & Budget Hearings

Commissioner Hendricks moved and Commissioner Russell seconded the motion to approve resolution 24-09 a resolution of the Elk County Rural Fire District #1 to levy a property tax rate exceeding the revenue neutral rate. Motion carried 3-0. Commissioner Hendricks moved and Commissioner Russell seconded the motion to approve resolution 24-08 a roll call vote of Elk County Rural Fire District #1 to levy a property tax exceeding the revenue neutral rate. Motion carried 3-0. Commissioner Hendricks moved and Commissioner Russell seconded the motion to approve and adopt the 2025 Elk County Rural Fire District #1 budget as presented. Motion carried 3-0.

#### Public Forum

Justin Spiehs spoke of free speech, constitutional rights, and county policies. Michael with Lawrence Accountability spoke of an arrest made in front of the courthouse that was unconstitutional and county policies not being followed. Kaye Spooner spoke of the notice put out by SISSA and spoke of election security. Janet Harrington stated she was the sheriff for Elk County for 17 years and she said she is ashamed of how the department is working now. Mrs. Harrington asked the Commissioners if they attended the new commission training when they were elected into office and if any constitutional law was taught at the training. Mrs. Harrington would like the Commission to start to follow the constitutional laws.

## **EMS**

Gillian Beaumont stated John Hester resigned and she will be posting a job opening. The grant funding for Abby Bowman was approved in the amount of \$1,500.

### **Emergency Management**

Erica Cordell stated the vehicle maintenance was done on the county car.

### Health

Kandy Dowell stated she is taking applications for an EMS/Health billing clerk. Commissioner Russell moved and Commissioner Hendricks seconded the motion to give Kristina Hanks a merit increase from \$23.34 an hour to \$23.84 an hour. Motion carried 3-0.

### Public Works

Don Sanders presented the Commission with quotes for the HVAC, windows, and electrical work of the courthouse.

## **Community Development**

Shari Kaminska stated Lemonade Day will be Saturday during Labor Day weekend. Ms. Kaminska spoke with Rick Pemberton with the KCC regarding the courthouse projects.

Rachel Ware presented on the behalf of Klenda Austerman LLC regarding the county tax sale.

### County Clerk
