Commissioner Russell moved and Commissioner Hendricks seconded the motion to approve the hire of Alexander McWilliams as a prn paramedic at \$20.00 per hour. Motion carried 2-0.

Chris Miller presented a new NRP to the commission.

Emergency Management

Erica Cordell attended the Healthcare Coalition meeting in Chanute on October 29, 2024 and the monthly KEMA meeting in Allen County on November 5, 2024. On November 7, 2024 Erica Cordell, Commissioner Hendricks, Shari Kaminska, Kandy Dowell, and Jane Koster attended the Regional TTX exercise about water shortage in Chanute. This will credit the county toward the required exercises for the Emergency Management Preparedness Grant for 2024. All sirens passed the siren test on November 12, 2024. A reminder the Integrated Preparedness Planning Workshop will be this Thursday at 6:30 p.m. at the Cox Building. Ms. Cordell would like to purchase a jetpack wireless router from Verizon and add the monthly cost of \$40.00 to her cell phone line. This will allow her to be able to work remotely at a call-out. The commission agreed that Ms. Cordell could purchase the jetpack wireless router.

Public Works

Don Sanders present an agreement with Montgomery County on hazardous waste to the commission. Mr. Sanders stated he would like to have Todd Winscher put up a fence around the county yard in Howard. Mr. Sanders would like an executive session for non-elected personnel to discussion an employee review.
